

# Fire Station Siting - Town of Bristol

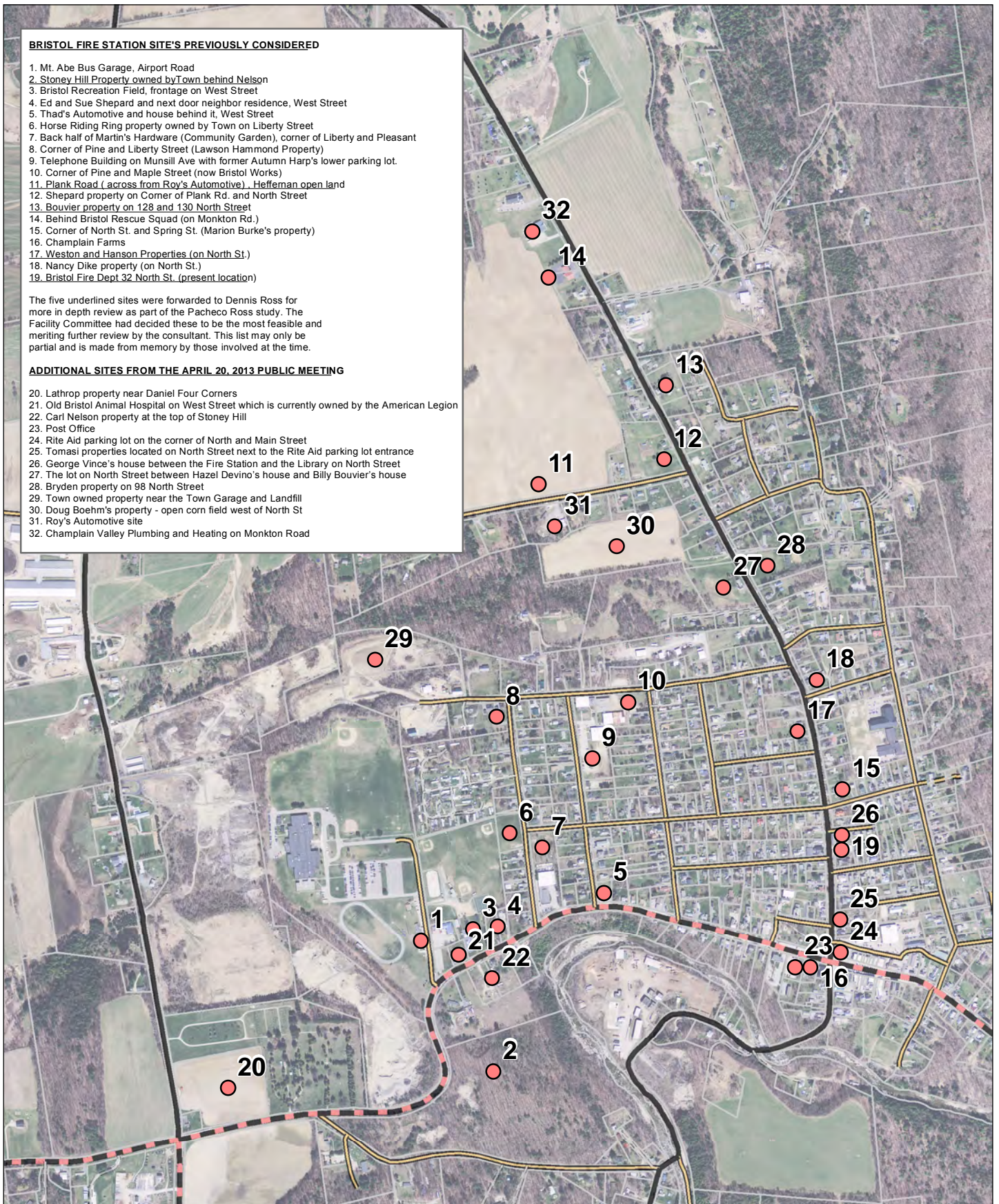
## BRISTOL FIRE STATION SITE'S PREVIOUSLY CONSIDERED

1. Mt. Abe Bus Garage, Airport Road
2. Stoney Hill Property owned by Town behind Nelson
3. Bristol Recreation Field, frontage on West Street
4. Ed and Sue Shepard and next door neighbor residence, West Street
5. Thad's Automotive and house behind it, West Street
6. Horse Riding Ring property owned by Town on Liberty Street
7. Back half of Martin's Hardware (Community Garden), corner of Liberty and Pleasant
8. Corner of Pine and Liberty Street (Lawson Hammond Property)
9. Telephone Building on Munsill Ave with former Autumn Harp's lower parking lot.
10. Corner of Pine and Maple Street (now Bristol Works)
11. Plank Road ( across from Roy's Automotive), Heffernan open land
12. Shepard property on Corner of Plank Rd. and North Street
13. Bouvier property on 128 and 130 North Street
14. Behind Bristol Rescue Squad (on Monkton Rd.)
15. Corner of North St. and Spring St. (Marion Burke's property)
16. Champlain Farms
17. Weston and Hanson Properties (on North St.)
18. Nancy Dike property (on North St.)
19. Bristol Fire Dept 32 North St. (present location)

The five underlined sites were forwarded to Dennis Ross for more in depth review as part of the Pacheco Ross study. The Facility Committee had decided these to be the most feasible and meriting further review by the consultant. This list may only be partial and is made from memory by those involved at the time.
