Following this evening's public hearing on re-adoption of the Town Plan, the PC will work to finalize the Bristol Zoning Regulations and to consider any testimony on re-adoption of the Town Plan. Both documents will then be advanced to the Selectboard for final recommendations and ultimately to the public for a vote (planning for March, 2017 Town Meeting). Adam Lougee, Executive Director of the Addison County Regional Planning Commission (ACRPC), continues to serve as the Planning Commission's consultant in this process.

Following the Public Hearing phase of this evening's meeting, public comments on tonight's agenda will be called for at an appropriate juncture during other deliberations. We will hear public comments on other topics at the conclusion of our evening's deliberations.
