Re: Request from Vergennes Union High School Class of 2019

The Vergennes Union High School Class of 2019 is requesting permission to walk on roads in Lincoln ending at the Zeno Mountain Farm on October 15th.. VUHS seniors traditionally choose a cause to walk for in the fall and raise enough money to make a difference. The walk-a-thon time is between the hours of 9:00 am - 2:00 pm. We are also asking if a week ahead of time we can put signs along the route to give drivers notice that a group will be along the route on October 15th.

Below is a description explaining the purpose and who we are walking for:

The Vergennes Union High School Class of 2019 has chosen to “walk” for the *Love Your Brain Foundation* and *Zeno Mountain Farm* who have a partnership to offer a healthy and positive camp-style retreat for people affected by brain injury. This is a cause near and dear to our hearts, one of our classmates experienced a TBI as a child and we are doing this walk with and for him. On October 15th we will walk and run to Zeno Mountain Farm in Lincoln, Vermont. The *Love Your Brain Foundation* is “a non-profit organization that improves the quality of life for people affected by traumatic brain injury (TBI) and raises awareness about the importance of brain health.” *Zeno Mountain Farm* “champions lifelong friendships and opportunity for people with disabilities and other marginalized communities”.

Our route will start at the firehouse behind the Jerusalem Store proceed down Downingville Road to Quaker Street and then up to Zeno Mountain Road. We are considering an alternate route starting in Bristol at Briggs Hill Road to West River Road then to Quaker Street. There will be @ 98 students, teachers, and parents walking with a bus following and a lead car.
